News and Notes from the Principal

Nau mai, haere mai.

Ngā mihi nui kia koutou katoa

As you will be aware there is a nationwide focus on student attendance. This term schools are required to be reporting to the Ministry of Education on weekly attendance. It is important that you let us know if your child is going to be absent for a day or intends to be absent for a portion of the school term for whatever reason. The Ministry of Education has clarified that parents should not be taking children on holidays during term time. With overseas holidays, I have always been of the view that missing school is sometimes unavoidable due to the different holiday times in the other parts of the world and that seeing family can't always fit neatly in between New Zealand holidays. However, parents need to know that the Ministry of Education now requires all schools to send to them data of children recorded as absent due to being overseas or on holiday.

The good health of your child is important to your child, their peers, you at home and the school staff. We know children will often insist on attending school, but we ask you to be firm and make adult decisions that are in the best interests of your child and the other children in the class. Ask yourself the following questions when your child is sick/ill....

- Is my child well enough to do the activities of the school day? If not, keep your child at home.
- Does my child have a condition that could be passed on to other children or school staff? If so, keep your child at home.
- Would I take a day off work if I had this condition? If so, keep your child at home.

If your child is suffering from sickness and/or diarrhoea, they must not return to school until 36 hours AFTER their last bout of sickness/diarrhoea. Thank you for your understanding with this.


If your child is to be absent from school, please ring the school office or use the school app service before 8:55am so the school is aware of your child's whereabouts.

All Absences are marked electronically at the start of the day and after lunch—if your child arrives late to school they must go through the office and let Mrs Pluck know they have arrived.

For safety reasons, you will be contacted by the school if we are unsure of the whereabouts of your child. The school contacts parents of students who become sick during the school day, so please ensure the office has your correct contact details.

Attendance at Dunsandel School:

The Term One 2024 data for our school shows that 79% of our students regularly attended school which is the 90% or more attendance threshold.



Regular Attendance - Over 90% attendance which is the equivalent to missing fewer than 5 days across a term.

Irregular Attendance – Between 80%-90% attendance which is the equivalent to being absent for between 5 and 9 days across a term.

Moderate Absence - Between 70% and 80% attendance which is the equivalent to being absent for between 10 and 14.5 days across a term.

Chronic Absence - 70% attendance or less which is the equivalent to being absent for 15 or more days across a term.

According to the Education Counts website 61.7% of students attended school more than 90% of the time in Term 1 2024 across the country.

Assembly Thank-you to those who came along to our Assembly on Friday. We have an Assembly this Friday starting at 2:20pm with the children from Room 5 sharing. All welcome.

Lost Property – There is a high number of lost property in our bin. We have had a lot of children asking to help find their lost polar fleece's and jerseys due to the colder weather. It doesn't help if their uniform items are not named clearly. Please take the time to make sure your child's name is written on the tag or sewn on. If you have purchased second hand uniform, please ensure the previous owners name has been removed and re-labelled.

Hot Lunch Friday – Our HOT LUNCH FRIDAY is back! Here are some tips for a successful hot lunch.

- Write your child's name on the tinfoil before wrapping the item this will prevent their name from rubbing off the tinfoil.
- Place cooking paper on top of pizza before wrapping, this will prevent topping sticking to tinfoil.
- Do not use paper sticky labels or cellotape as these catch fire in the oven.
- Always write what the item is so we know how long to keep in the oven.
- Never use plastic containers.
- One item per child please, we don't have enough space for more than one item.
- Hot lunch Friday is for slowly heating food in the oven we will not be heating food in the microwave or heating noodles with boiling water.
- We don't have spare tinfoil at school, so please wrap your child's item before coming to school.


Wanted: Friesian bull calves
