Welcome to term three

I hope you and your whānau enjoyed the holidays and you are all ready for the new term. We have a very busy and exciting time ahead, with lots of activities, visitors, events and of course the best day of the year, Country day.

#### **Building Works**

At the moment there are two building projects happening. The admin building has new cladding going up and the classrooms that are the original Room 1 & 2 are being modernised inside. While it is exciting for the children to watch, there are some challenges with movement around the school. The builders have done a great job keeping us a safe distance from the worksites and there are mat pathways for us to walk on. For now, our bus teams will assemble on the court outside Room 4 & 5 so that we have a clear space to organise the children. The bus teams will leave school through the side gate next to the staffroom. I thank you for your patience while collecting and dropping off your children from school.

We expect all of the work to be finished by the end of week 3.

#### Speed Signs

At the end of last term, as part of a new road safety initiative, Selwyn District Council put up new speed restriction signs either side of our school on Irvines Road. These signs flash for 10 minutes before and after school to remind drivers to slow down while in a school zone. The Council are placing these signs outside many rural schools in the Selwyn District. It is also a good time for a reminder that when you pass a stationery school bus, you need to slow down to 20kph, regardless of which direction you or the bus are travelling in.

**Year 5 and 6 ski trip** is next Thursday at Porter Heights ski field. If you have a child in Year's 5 and 6 and haven't returned your ski form, please contact the school office.

**Term 3 after school Routine –** Some families have changes in their after school routine and to make things run smoothly on these days, it is important for us to know which direction we are sending your children home. # Dunsandel School PTA 2024 Calf Fundraiser


#### Wanted: Friesian bull calves
