Hot Lunch Friday – HOT LUNCH FRIDAY! Here are some tips for a successful hot lunch.

- Write your child's name on the tinfoil before wrapping the item this will prevent their name from rubbing off the tinfoil.
- Place cooking paper on top of pizza before wrapping, this will prevent topping sticking to tinfoil.
- Do not use paper sticky labels or cellotape as these catch fire in the oven.
- Always write what the item is so we know how long to keep in the oven.
- Never use plastic containers.
- One item per child please, we don't have enough space for more than one item.
- Hot lunch Friday is for slowly heating food in the oven we will not be heating food in the microwave or heating noodles with boiling water.
- We don't have spare tinfoil at school, so please wrap your child's item before coming to school.
- Never wrap items in glad-wrap and cover with tinfoil. This causes plastic to shrink wrap around the item and becomes inedible. We do not have time to open every item to check.

Chocolate Fundraiser

Our Annual Chocolate Fundraiser is back! Every year we send home a box of chocolate with the eldest child of the family to sell, you should have your box today. They are \$2 each bar, \$60 per box. All money must be back by **Friday 16th August.**

Health and Wellbeing

Head-lice – Head-lice is out in our school. Head lice are small insects that live on the human scalp. They are common and anyone can catch head lice; catching them has nothing to do with not being clean. Please check your child's hair and if you find live head lice or eggs treat them. You can purchase treatment from the local supermarket or chemist. The 'wet combing' with cheap conditioner and a fine-tooth head lice (nit) comb is an effective way to find and remove head lice, if done properly. Make sure your child's hair is tied back every day as they can crawl from one person to another. **Conjunctivitis** - is causing havoc in our school community, please keep your child home if your child has conjunctivitis. Thank you to the families that have notified us. If you are unsure if your child has it or not, please see your local pharmacist or doctor.


