Welcome back!

Welcome to week one, of the last term of the 2024 school year! I hope your children enjoyed their holiday break and are now ready for a busy term!

This term we welcome back Mr R. He is currently travelling back from his Principal Study Group and we hope to see him at school later this week.

Because there are lots of things happening this term, I encourage you to read all of the newsletters that come home, including class newsletters and any notices informing you about class trips etc. Most events will be listed in future newsletters and on our school website.

Sunhats/bare feet -This term the children are required to wear a sunhat during break times at school. There is a wide brimmed navy hat that is part of our school uniform. If your child doesn't have their sunhat at school, they will be required to play in the shaded areas of the playground and they are not allowed over the road to play. Your child is also allowed to have bare feet at school as long as they have their sunhat. They must wear shoes when travelling to and from school. You can purchase hats from the office at \$13 while stock last. You can order hats at Mainland uniforms or at The Warehouse.

Wellness – Some children may require medication for allergies like hay fever. You can send your child to school with antihistamines, but they need to be given to the office with their name written on them and will only be given to them when required. A reminder that we have a child with a severe peanut allergy and to be mindful of what goes in your child's lunches – Please no peanut-butter or peanut bars.
